

Policy for Member Awards

(Effective Jan. 1, 2017)

To be eligible for any of the awards listed below, the committee must receive a signed and attested scorecard.

Birdies: Members will be given one lifetime birdie pin for each of the 27 holes at SaddleBrooke Golf Club. The birdie must be obtained during a league event where the score is acceptable for handicap posting. The ball must have been holed.

Note: If a member is disqualified for sweeps due to picking up her ball on another hole, the birdie award will be given as long as it meets the above criteria.

Eagles for par 4 or par 5 holes: Any member who makes an eagle on a par 4 or par 5 hole on a league event day will be awarded a pin and a \$50 Golf Shop credit. The Eagle must be obtained during a league event where the score is acceptable for handicap posting. The ball must have been holed.

A member who makes an eagle on a par 4 or par 5 hole on a non- league day will receive a pin upon providing the Handicap Chair with a copy of an attested score card.

Hole-in-One: Any member who makes a hole in one on a league event day will be awarded a pin and a \$50 Golf Shop credit. A member who makes a hole in one on a non- league day on one of the SaddleBrooke One courses will receive a pin upon providing the Handicap Chair with a copy of an attested score card.

Breaking 50, 45, or 40: Starting January 1, 2017 a member will be given one lifetime award per nine hole course on SaddleBrooke One courses upon breaking 50, 45, or 40. The score must be obtained during a league event where the score is acceptable for handicap posting. The member must play and complete all nine holes. The member must not have been disqualified due to picking up on any hole or for breach of a rule during play.

Note: Tracking of awards for scores under 50 will be started anew on January 1, 2017. If you received an award for a score under 50 in the past, you may be awarded another award with this new policy.

Note: If a member achieves a score under 45 prior to being awarded a pin for a score under 50, she will receive both awards.

Most improved player: The USGA formula will be used to determine the most improved golfer for the year. To be eligible, a player must be a member of the club as of January 1st and must post at least 20 scores from January 1st through November 1st of the current year with at least 10 of those scores on Niners' league day event. Penalty scores will not be included in the handicap calculations.

State Medallion: Competition is open to all AWGA members and will consist of the 2 best low gross and the 2 best low net 9-hole rounds out of 4 designated rounds on a league play day. Players need not

participate in all 4 rounds to be eligible. In the event of a tie, a 9-hole playoff shall be held within a period of 2 weeks. All play will be from the Red Tees.

Ringer Board: Ringer Board is your best score on each of the 27 holes from January through November. Each time a player improves on a hole that new score is entered. If on any hole the ball is not holed out, the score for that hole will not be considered. On December 1st all participants (who have at least 1 score for each of the 27 holes) will be placed into flights by handicap. The winner/s will be the lady/ladies with the lowest net score. The number of flights and winners is determined by the number of participants. You can sign up for Ringer Board up till August 31st and the cost is \$5.00. Of course the sooner you sign up the more chances you will have of improving your scores. (Scores are only tracked from the date you pay your entry fee.)

Note: A handicap adjustment will be made in accordance with USGA Handicap Guidelines section 3-5 for those Ringer Board participants who play from the aqua tees for the entire season.
