## Help! My ball is in the decorative rock!

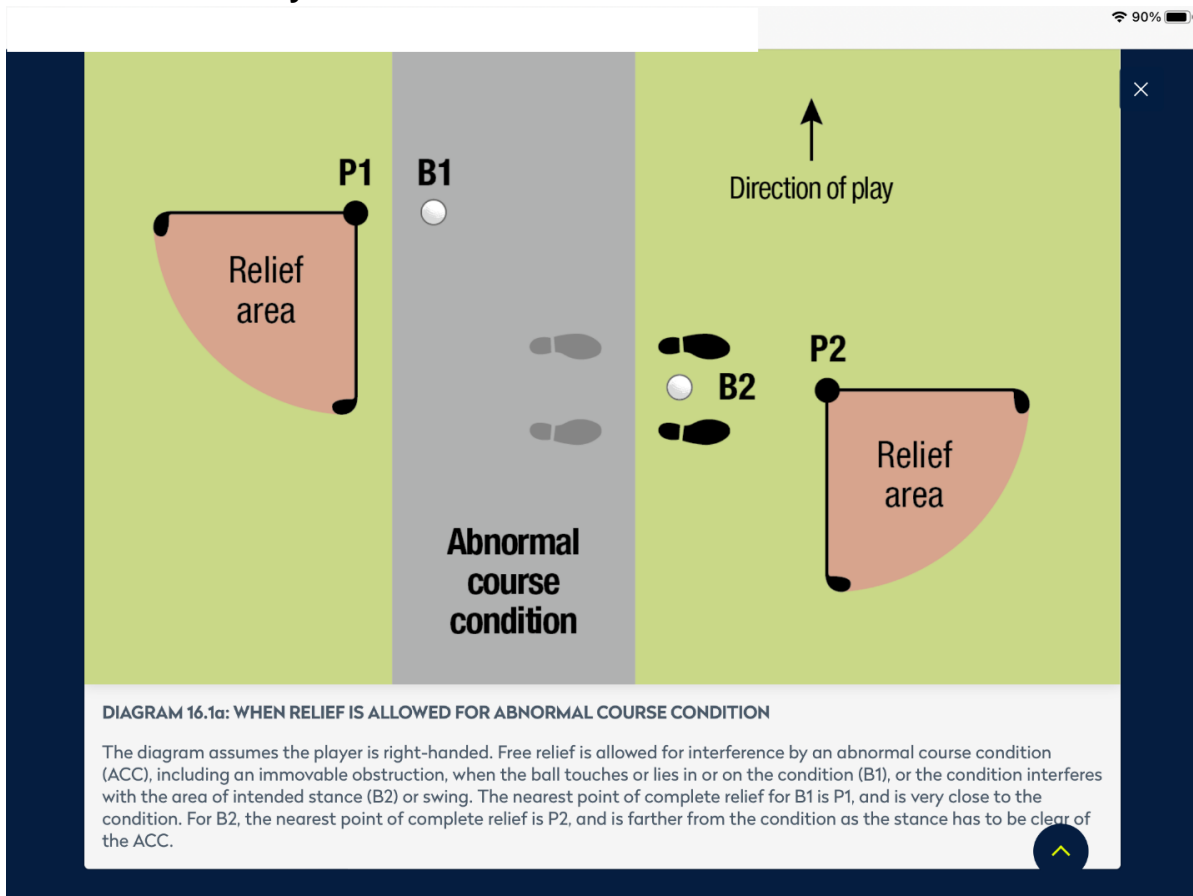
You **MUST** take free relief under Rule 16.1.

These are the steps to take free relief.

- 1) Choose the club for your next shot.
- 2) Find your point of relief. Take your stance outside the rock.
- 3) Measure one club length (use your longest club that is not a putter) from your stance and put a tee at the end of the club.
- 4) Drop your ball from your knee. If it rolls outside the area, pick it up and drop it again. If it still rolls out, place it where it first touched the ground.
- 5) Play your shot.

# RULES

The diagram below shows how to take relief from the cart path or any other abnormal course condition. The position of the ball determines which side of the cart path or any other abnormal course condition you will take relief.



There is no penalty stroke for free relief. Let's practice the correct procedure for taking free relief. The process is speeded up if you have two tees in your pocket and have the steps in your mind.

Congratulations to our 2022 President's Cup Winner:

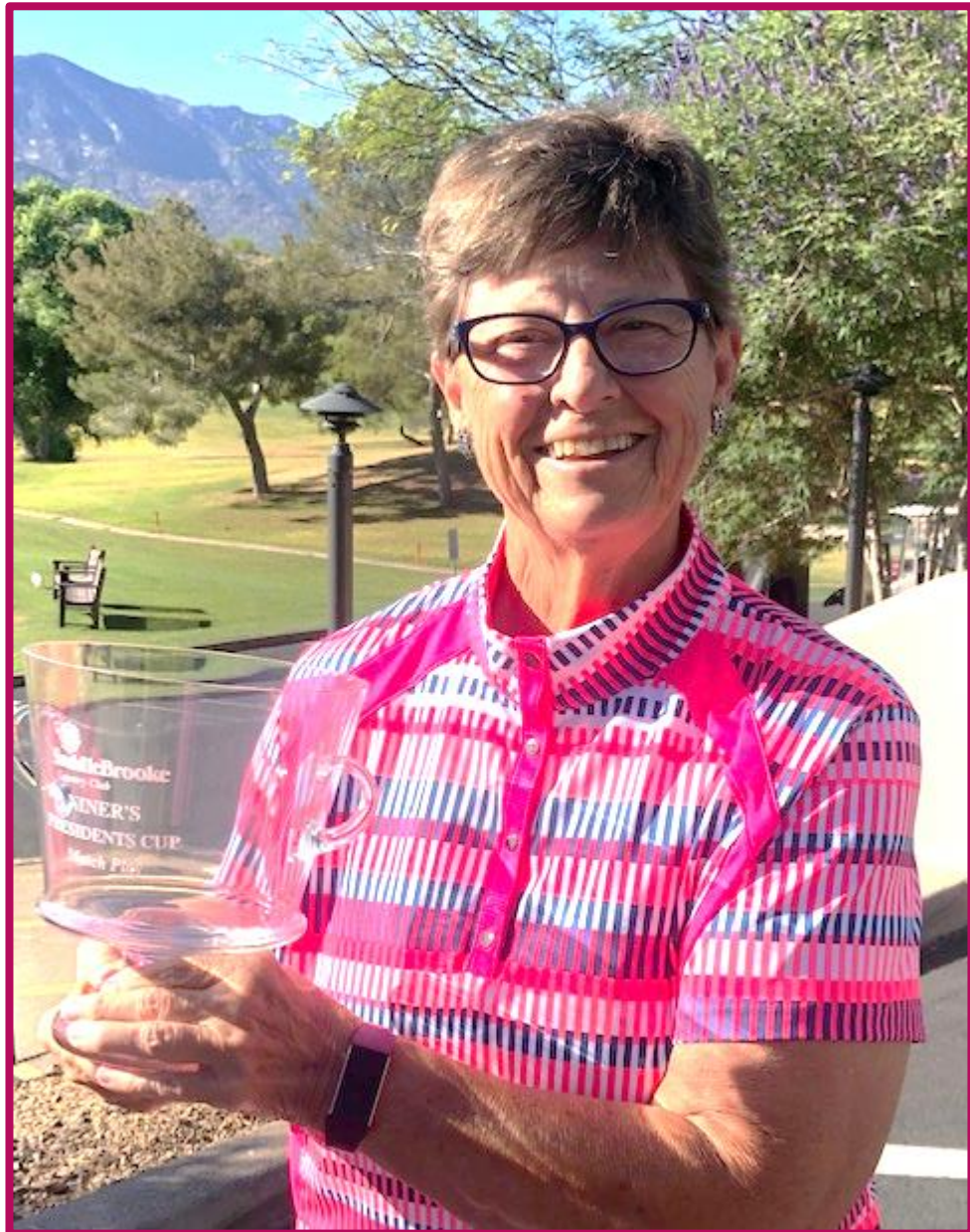
**TERRI TINDAL**
