

## Revised Policy

### Scorecards and Maximum Strokes per Hole

(Approved 8/3/2015 – Effective 8/11/15)

If a player chooses to pick up her ball or is required to pick up her ball and does not finish a hole, please precede the player's maximum equitable stroke control score or her most likely score for the hole with an X; i.e., X5. A player who starts, but does not complete a hole, must record for handicap purposes her most likely score. The most likely score may not exceed the player's **equitable stroke control score**. Any time you pick up without completing the hole, the player is disqualified (DQ) from the game of the day (prize money). Write DQ directly behind your name on the scorecard.

#### Maximum Hole Score for Regular League Events

To aid Pace of Play, players are required to pick up prior to finishing the hole when their score for the hole has or will reach double par plus two. See the chart below:

Hole Par	Pick up when your score reaches
3	8
4	10
5	12

The score listed on the card will show the player's maximum equitable stroke control score (or most likely score) for that hole with an "X". This makes her ineligible for any prize money for that league event.

Every player must sign the scorecard before it is turned in to the green box on the shelf beneath the Niners' bulletin board.

Players who do not complete all holes are still required to post their score for handicap purposes.

This policy may be waived by the Executive Board for special events or tournaments.
