JANUARY'S RULE

In preparation for the job of Rules Chair, I asked some of my golf partners what questions they have regarding rules that they would like further explanation. This one came up:

Rule 2.3 Objects or Conditions that can interfere with play. Certain Rules may give free relief (relief with no penalty) from interference by certain defined objects or conditions, such as, abnormal course conditions, which are animal holes, ground under repair, immovable obstructions and temporary water (Rule 16.1).

Speaking of Holes #5 and #7 Catalina, the first cart bridge on #5 and the cart bridge on the left side when approaching the green on #7:

When your ball lands in the ditch area before the bridge, you are allowed free relief. This means you can place your ball back - no closer to the green - but only far enough to allow your swing to be unobstructed.

In other words, you cannot place your ball in the fairway, and you cannot place your ball farther back than just enough to swing your club without hitting the bridge with your club when you swing.
