## Tee Choice – Red, Aqua, or Red/Aqua Combo (Revised January 2019)

You may choose your tee for league play (either the Red Tees, Aqua Tees or the Red/Aqua Combo Tees). Once you have made a tee choice we ask that you continue using that tee for the year. You may make one (1) tee change during the year purely at your discretion by notifying the Membership Chair in writing or email. The Executive Board may rule on additional changes of tee choice on an individual basis.

If you opt to compete from the Aqua Tees or Red/Aqua Combo, your course handicap for these tees will be adjusted on league days as needed to make the competition fair to all players. The scorecards provided for league events will have the correct handicap strokes for use. (Please see handicap rule 3-5 for an explanation of adjusting the handicap.)

You must play from the Red Tees to compete in the Club Championship, President's Cup, and State Medallion. You may opt to Follow the Field for these events, playing from your usual tee color, and be eligible for the weekly sweeps.

Committees for special events may set the tee requirements for their individual event.

**Ringer Board:** Ringer Board is your best league day score on each of the 27 holes from January through November. Each time a player improves on a hole that new score is entered. If on any hole the ball is not holed out, the score for that hole will not be considered. On December 1<sup>st</sup> all participants (who have at least 1 score for each of the 27 holes) will be placed into flights by handicap. The winner/s will be the lady/ladies with the lowest net score. The number of flights and winners is determined by the number of participants. You can sign up for Ringer Board till August 31<sup>st</sup> and the cost is \$5.00. Of course the sooner you sign up the more chances you will have of improving your scores. (Scores are only tracked from the date you pay your entry fee.)

Note: A handicap adjustment will be made in accordance with USGA Handicap Guidelines section 3-5 for those Ringer Board participants who play from the aqua tees or the red/aqua combo tees for the entire season.
